Fujifilm's Wide Link Smartphone Printer does just that. The Instax Film–using printer connects to his phone wirelessly via Bluetooth, so he can easily snap someone's portrait and share a physical copy with them on the spot. At just eight inches long, it's hardly bigger than the larger iPhone models, and it's powered by a rechargeable battery. And if he's the type to endlessly tinker with editing, he'll appreciate that the printer's software lets him play around with extra filters and customizations before
